Advice EXAMPLES

Example Sentences:

Good advice would really help the confused.

The doctors gave me the same advice.

How do I know if the advice is good or not?

Listen to my advice; it's for your own good.



Tips for using Advice

Advice refers to the suggestion for a beneficial course of action.

He who can take advice is sometimes superior to him who can give it.

There is nothing wrong about asking for advice.

You need to ask the doctor's advice about your health condition.

None of their advice worked for me.

Example Dialogue:

Lisa : What was the doctor's advice regarding your health condition?

Tin : He told me to take medicine and get ample rest.

Lisa : Did it make you feel any better?

Tin : Yes. I'm glad I followed his advice.

ADVICE: (noun) suggestion for a beneficial course of action

Advise EXAMPLES

Example Sentences:

I always advise her, but she never listens.

Everyone can advise each other.

She advised me not to go.

She's not good at advising people.

Tips for using Advise

Use "Advise" to give advice.

I advise you not to leave the company.

Thank people who always advise you.

My mom never gets tired of advising me.

Please advise her to listen to me.

Example Dialogue:

Pin : I want to go with Dad to Singapore.

Lim : I advise you not to go, because you have exams next week.

Pin : Ok, I'll study now. Thanks for advising me mom.

Lim : Don't worry; I'll take you there after your exams.
