Sight EXAMPLES

Example Sentences:

She's squeamish! She cannot stand the **sight** of blood.

She lost **sight** when she was 10 years old due to a car accident.

Mary lost her **sight** as a baby.

Her **sight** became perfect after the laser treatment.



Tips for using Sight

"Sight" *ability to see with your eyes; the act of seeing; any place that you can see from where you are; interesting places to visit*

People with poor **sight** should use glasses.

I think my **sight** is getting worse and worse as I am growing older.

The policeman lost **sight** of the robber.

It was love at first **sight** between those two.

Example Dialogue:

Greg: I think we have lost **sight** of the tourist guide.

Diane: Maybe we took a wrong turn somewhere.

Greg : Probably. I hope we won't get lost.

Diane : No, we won't. If I catch **sight** of something suspicious, I will notify you.

DEFINITION:

SIGHT: *vision; the act of seeing; a place that you can see from where you are; interesting places to visit*

Tips for using **Site**

Site "a place where something is built or something interesting happened; a place for a particular purpose; a website"

The architects did an audit of the site.

We visited the site of the battle that happened in 1449.

They are developing a new site without any advertisements.

We visited all the historical sites in this town.

William : Well, the company finds this area to be a very convenient site.

Ellen : I see. It's at the very heart of the city.
