Brows EXAMPLES

Example Sentences:

What color are your brows?

She is so fortunate to have thick brows.

Brows also serve as a protection for the eyes from any liquid pouring down the head.

Rebecca has very thin brows.



*Tips for using **Brows***

***"Brows"** is used to refer to the hairs above the eyes and below the forehead (short for eyebrows)*

People have different brows as they have different finger prints.

It is better to have your brows the same color as your hair.

Girls either pluck or shave their brows to make them look defined.

Men don't care how their brows look.

Example Dialogue:

Carol : Do you groom your brows?

Ressa : As a matter of fact, I do. I usually pluck them until I achieve my desired shape.

Carol : You're so lucky to have thick brows. Yours are infinitely malleable!

DEFINITION:

BROWS: *the hairs above the eyes and below the forehead. (eyebrows)*

“Browse” means to look for something or read with no particular aim.

I don't know how to browse the Internet and look for websites.

It was during computer class when the teacher taught us how to browse the Internet.

Example Dialogue:

Leen : How do you know all these cooking tips? Do you often browse the Internet?

Jade : No, unfortunately I don't know how to use the computer. I learned this from
the cooking magazines.

Leen : Wow, that's cool. Can I borrow some?

Jade : Yes, sure you can. It's really worth browsing.

DEFINITION:

BROWSE: look for something or read without any particular aim.
