Made of EXAMPLES

Our house is made of wood.

We created a miniature building made of clay.

The picture frame was made of popsicle sticks.

I found a cute bouquet made of fruits.



Tips for using **Made of**

“Made of” is used to refer to something that keeps its form.

Many things nowadays seem to be made of plastic.

This camera is made of metal.

That bicycle looks like it's made of wood.

I like using clothespins that are made of wood.

Example Dialogue:

Chinee : That house was made of stone.

Kred : The designers made it like that because stone is durable and uniquely stylish.

Chinee : The furniture inside was made of indigenous materials. I think the designers are trying to show people how to be resourceful.

Kred : I think you have a point there.

Tips for using **Made from**

"Made from" is used if the form is changed during the process of making.

I am drinking medicine made from different herbs.

This candy is made from vegetables.

I have tasted ice cream that was made from cabbage.

The famous whitening mask is made from oranges.
