Terror attack in Southern Russia

Another terrorist attack happened in a shop in southern Russia which led to increased security concerns about next year's Winter Olympics in nearby Sochi.

An explosion that led to one death and two injuries in a shop in Makhachkala happened on Friday. Local police say a group of three men forced their way inside the shop; they fired their guns and detonated an explosive.

Two people were also killed on October 30 in a place near Makhachkala, where shops had been targeted by bomb attacks.

No one has yet claimed responsibility for the 2 terror attacks, but it has been known that the Islamist militants are a threat to southern Russia's security situation.

On the 21st of last month, a female suicide bomber set off explosives on a moving bus in Volgograd, causing the death of 6 people.

Sochi Winter Olympic Games will begin next February. The Islamist extremists warned that they would try to prevent such an occasion from happening by any possible means.

The explosion happened despite the fact that the Russian authorities have tightened the security measures, which consequently increased the concerns of the citizens about the recent attack.

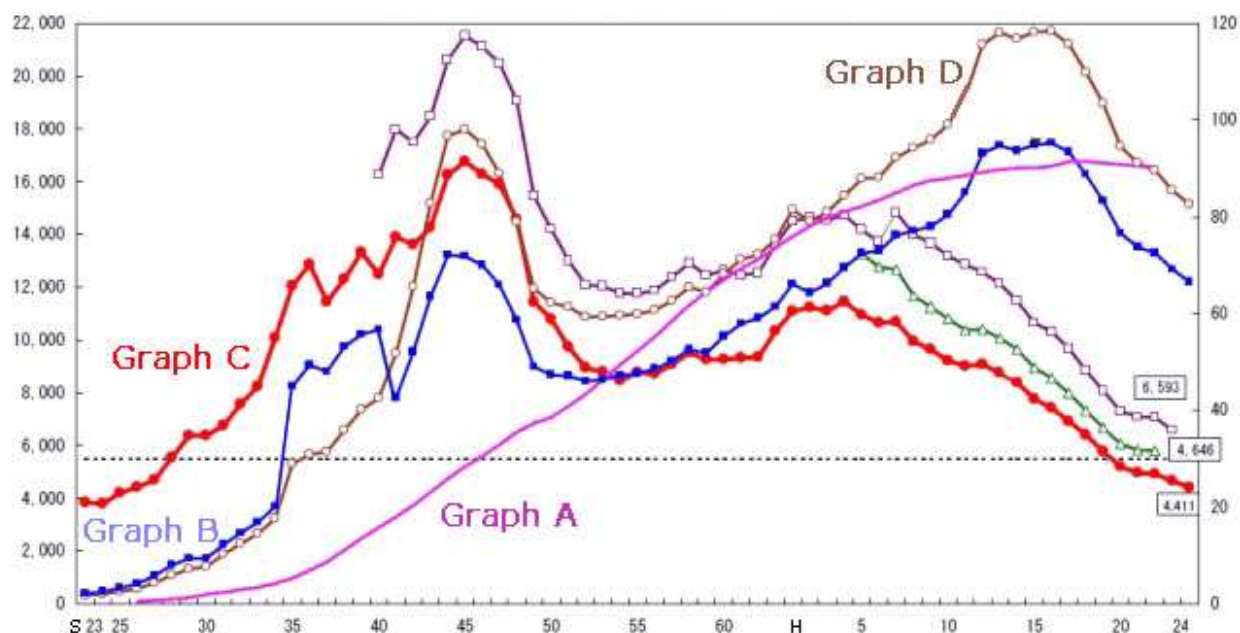
**Definition of the points:**
