**Struggles of the Philippine rescuers**

The rescue teams in the Philippines are struggling to be of some avail to more than 9.6 million victims of Typhoon Haiyan.

Tacloban and other areas of Leyte Island were smashed by this Typhoon on Friday. According to the authorities, 13,000 homes were destroyed and a total of 255 people confirmed dead. It is estimated that the actual death toll might reach 10,000.

A full summary of the catastrophe could not be determined because of downed communication systems and shattered infrastructures.

The Terminal building and control towers were badly damaged at the Tacloban airport causing two days of delayed arrival of the military aircraft and rescue teams altogether with the relief goods that should have been distributed to the local residents who were waiting for food and water.

A temporary clinic was set up at the airport to help injured people and pregnant women. But it has an apparent shortage of medical teams and supplies.

An abundant support was offered by the international community, including Japan, in the form of sending a rescue team and deploying helicopters from the US military to transport emergency supplies and to search for the missing people.

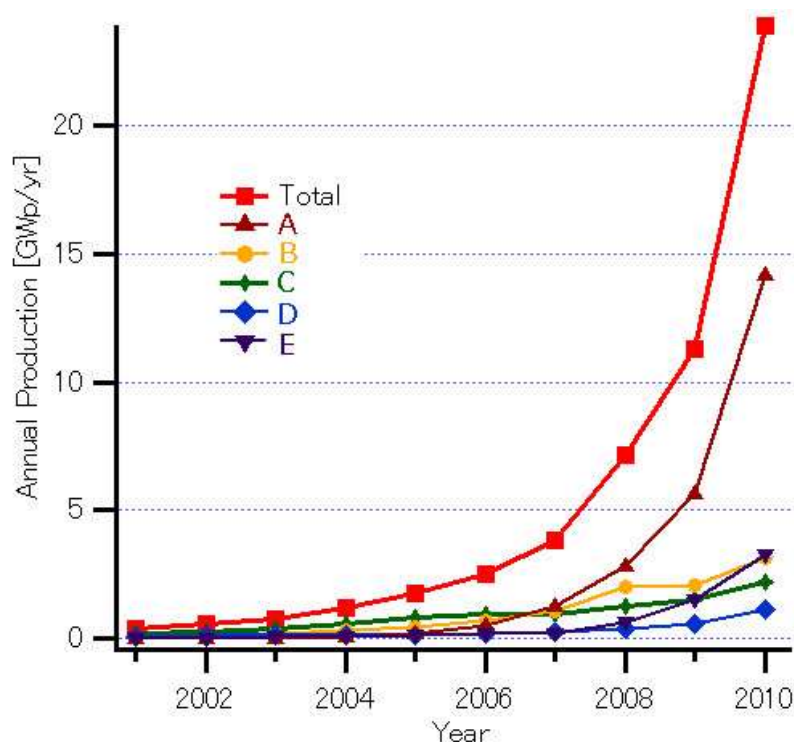
