Japan and India Promote Nuclear Pact

Representatives Fumio Kishida of Japan and Salman Khurshid of India met on Tuesday in New Delhi and agreed to promote negotiations regarding a civil nuclear pact during their attendance at the foreign ministerial talks of the Asia-Europe Meeting.

Japan is hoping to be more closely affiliated with India in expanding their bilateral strategic partnership. Khurshid responded that Japan and India must have talks and ministerial meetings to build deep affinity.

Both representatives agreed to intensify the negotiations on a pact that would allow Japan to spread nuclear power technology to India. The country is also planning to build nuclear power stations.

Kishida and Khurshid both agreed to make joint activities between Japan's Maritime Self Defense Force and India's Navy as part of the security cooperation.

The discussion confirmed that working group meetings should happen as soon as possible to further discuss various ways for Japan to export US-2 rescue aircraft to India.

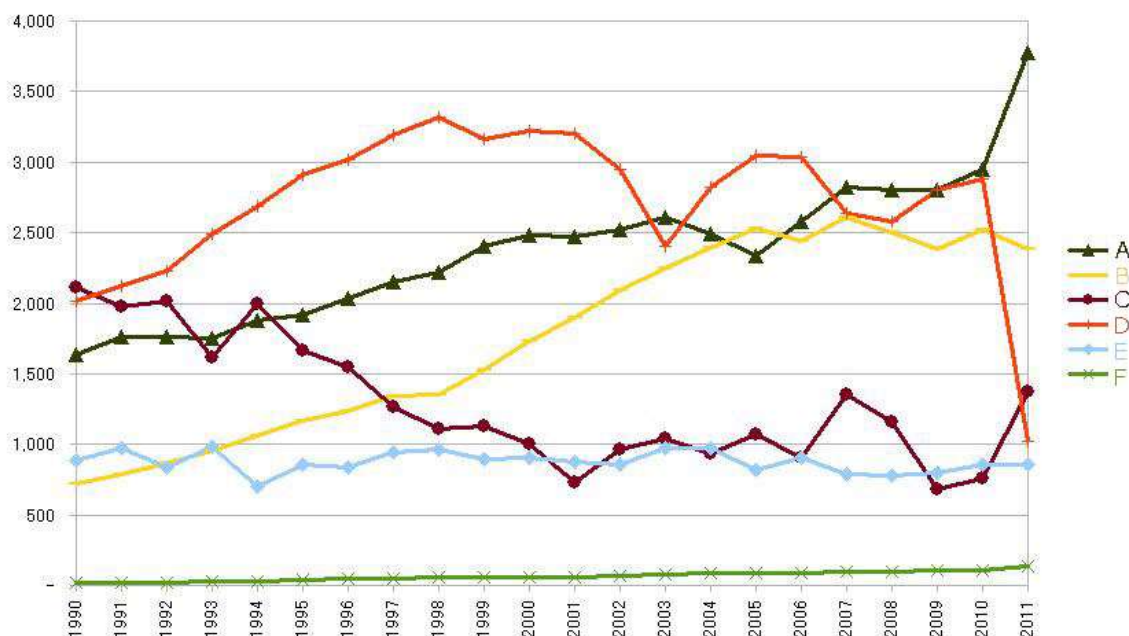
**Definition of the points:**
