Two Big US Airlines Set to Merge

American Airlines and US Airways have agreed with the Justice Department about antitrust lawsuit and are set to merge. This action will lead to the largest air carrier in the world.

The Justice Department said that they settled the lawsuit by letting two airlines give up some of the rights to take off and land at important US airports. It came into conclusion on Tuesday.

American Airlines filed for bankruptcy protection 2 years ago and the merger was supposed to become one of the main solutions to save the company. In February, American Airlines and US Airways officially announced their plans.

In August, the Justice Department filed an antitrust lawsuit against the merger. It said that the merger between the country's 3rd and 5th largest airlines will worsen the quality of airline services and raise airline fares, by hindering competition.

After the settlement, they are planning to merge completely by the end of the year.
