BMW to release new EV in Japan

BMW plans to release an electric vehicle with a carbon-fiber frame next April in Japan. The material is resistant to physical impact and weighs about half as much as iron.

The German automaker announced that the new model is the world's first mass-market, the new models are about 300 kilograms lighter than the usual frames made with iron. Automakers have been battling to find ways to compensate for the batteries that are used in electric cars because they only add to the weight.

Two models will be available on the market and the standard model can travel up to about 160 kilometers on a single charge according to the company's statement. The other model has a small gasoline engine that will be used as a generator, prolonging its range to 300 kilometers.

According to Alan Harris, the BMW Japan President the cars are the electric vehicle type that will make driving enjoyable for car owners because of its comfort.

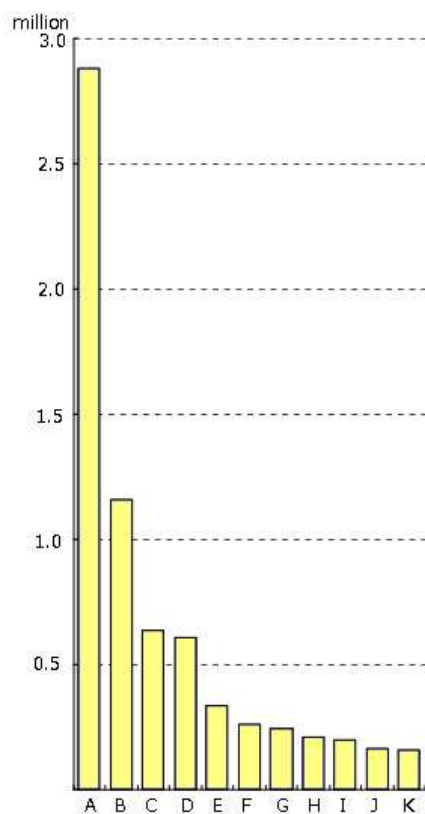
Directions: Look at the picture. 30 seconds are given to you. After that, your teacher will give you a cue. Describe the picture. 2 minutes are given to finish the description.
